The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, heard from the Competitors' Representatives and the Drivers concerned, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 3 / Josep Maria Martí
Competitor: Cupra Kiro
Session: Race
Time (fact): 14:44
Fact: Causing a collision with car 13 and car 51 at Turn 6-7
Offence: Breach of Article 16.1 d) of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations
Decision: Start from the back of the Grid for the next Race in which the Driver takes part (4 penalty points awarded, 4 in total)
Reason: Car 3 caused a collision with car 13 and car 51 at Turn 6-7. When Race Control deployed the FCY, cars 13 and 51 reacted correctly by reducing their speed during the countdown and selecting different lines to avoid a collision. Car 3, however, arrived at the scene too quickly and was unable to react in time to prevent an impact. Because this represents a worst-case scenario in terms of safety, the Stewards have decided to impose a severe penalty.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
