Fact: Mechanic working on the car while the car is in ready to move status.
Offence: Not respecting safety measures whilst car in ready to move status and Article 8.29 of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Technical Regulations
Decision: Fine of 1.000 €
Reason: The mechanics were working on the car although the car was in ready to move status.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
